

- Scenic Stays: Camp under the starlit Himalayan skies in picturesque locations.







- Manali to Solang valley
- Rest day

Meet and greet the Team for a briefing session.

This will include details about the day by day route plan, road condition details.



- Solang Valley to Jibhi
- 108km 4 hours drive

We will start our journey towards Jibhi. This is a short ride of 4 hours wherein we will cross Aut Tunnel and enter Banjar Valley.



- Jibhi to Rackcham (Chitkul)
- 213km 8 hours drive

We will leave for the beautiful village of Chitkul. It is the last habitable village near the Indo-China Border. The Ride will give you a glimpse of Kinnaur Valley.



- Rakcham to Tabo (Nako)
- 203km 7 hours drive
 We will head towards Nako. This will mark our entry
 into Spiti Valley. The ride is beautiful and gives you
 enough time to stop around for photoshoots and video
 shoots. Our stay is in Tabo for the night



- Tabo to Dhanker Monestry pin Valley to Kaza
- 110km 4 hours drive

We will leave for Lalung & Dhankar ~ both providing breathtaking views and landscapes.

Dhankar Monastery is one of the most spectacular and ancient monasteries in Spiti Valley.



- Kaza to Kaza Local
- 80km 4 hours drive

Today, this is the day wherein we will explore the gems of Kaza.

Komic is a remote village in Spiti valley. Having its fame as the Highest village in the world connected with a motorable road. .

Hikkim Village—home to the world's highest post office at an altitude of 4,400 meters.

Langza Village - a place which takes you back to village life! It is full of stories, history, and surreal beauty that will stun you! Known as the "Fossil Village."



- Kaza Village to Chandratal Lake
- 95km 5 hours drive

Crossing Kunzum Pass, we will head towards Chandratal.

Kunzum Pass ~ standing at 4,500 meters, it is a rugged gateway that takes people to a whole new world of majestic landscapes.

In the evening, we will walk towards Chandratal Lake. Situated at an altitude of 4300 meters, Chandratal offers the most splendid views of the Spiti region.



- Chandratal Lake to Jispa
- 138km 6 hours drive

We will leave for Jispa

After crossing the checkpost at Koksar, we will head towards Jispa.

Jispa is a small village in Lahaul district of Himachal Pradesh, surrounded by Himalayan hills and the Bhaga River.

Itinerary Day 9

- Jispa to Padum
- 150km 7 hours drive

This day will mark our journey from Lahaul Valley to Zanskar Valley via Shinkhula Pass.

Shinkula Pass height is 5,050 meters (16,580 feet), and is one of the tallest passes in this region. After we cross the Pass, we will halt at Gombo Rangdum ~ the holy and sacred mountain of the Zanskar Valley. Making our way towards Padum ~ Padum around 3505 m above the sea-level, is the administrative center of Zanskar.



- Padum to Padum Local
- 200km 8 hours drive

On the way to Padum to Padum Local you will witness the nighty Glacier. Drang Drung Glacier is a 23 km-long glacier and is the second-largest in Ladakh after Siachen. Sitting at 4,780 meters above sea level.

Pensi La is a 4,400 meters high mountain pass which connects
Suru valley of Kargil with Zanskar valley. At Pensi La top,
travellers are greeted with two small but beautiful lakes—Sta To
and Lang Tso.



- Padum to Purne
- 53km 4 hours drive

We will leave for Purne. It is a short ride, making it a perfect day for us to relax at Purne before we start our hike towards Phuktal Monastery. The Monastery is a legendary cave gompa and is counted as one of the only Buddhist monasteries in the region that is accessible only by foot.



- Purne to Solang Valley
- 170km 5 hours drive

Post Breakfast, we will leave for Manali via Atal Tunnel and Solang Valley.

Manali/Solang ~ the town is a mix of bustling cafes and charming resorts, making it the perfect place to end our circuit.
